

ORDINANCE NO. 8-20A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NO PARKING ZONES ON EITHER SIDE OF OAK HILL DRIVE FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH HWY. 173 FOR ITS ENTIRE LENGTH; ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE DURING OVERNIGHT HOURS FOR THE WEST SIDE OF OAK HILL DRIVE AND NO PARKING ZONES FOR THE EAST SIDE OF OAK HILL DRIVE AND ALL OF THE CUL-DE-SAC OF OAK HILL DRIVE DURING ALL HOURS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

WHEREAS: The City of Devine is a duly incorporated city under the general laws of the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS: Texas Transportation Code Section 311.002 (1999) authorizes any city incorporated under the General Laws of the State of Texas to regulate the use of its streets; and,

WHEREAS: The Texas Local Government Code, Section 51.001 authorizes the governing body of a municipality to adopt, publish, amend, or repeal an ordinance, rule, or police regulation that is for the good government, peace, or order of the municipality or for the trade and commerce of the municipality and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the municipality or to an office or department of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEVINE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. No-Parking Zones. That a no-parking zone be established for the West side of Oak Hill Drive during overnight hours and no-parking zones for the East side of Oak Hill Drive and all of the cul-de-sac of Oak Hill Drive during all hours.

SECTION 2. Code of Ordinances. It is the intention of the City Council that this Ordinance shall become a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Devine and may be renumbered and codified therein accordingly.

SECTION 3. Repeal. Any provision in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Devine that conflicts with this ordinance is hereby repealed.


SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval and official publication as provided by law but shall not be enforced until the proper signs have been erected and/or proper markings applied.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any section, provision, subdivision, clause or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged or held unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any other part or provision contained herein.
